The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (Commission) met as noticed. Present were Chairperson Valcq, Commissioner Nowak and Commissioner Huebner.

Minutes

The Commission approved the minutes of the open meeting of Thursday, December 10, 2020.

240-CW-102 - Application of the Village of Arlington, as a Water Public Utility, for Authority to Construct Well No. 4, in the Village of Arlington, Columbia County, Wisconsin

The Commission approved the Notice of Investigation and directed it to be signed by the Secretary to the Commission.

3295-CW-100 - Application of the Village of Maiden Rock, as a Water Public Utility, for Authority to Construct Well No. 2 in the Village of Maiden Rock, Pierce County, Wisconsin

The Commission approved the Notice of Investigation and directed it to be signed by the Secretary to the Commission.

1-AC-256 - In the Matter of Rulemaking to Update Wisconsin Administrative Code Chapter PSC 119 for Interconnecting Distributed Generation Facilities

Request to Open Rulemaking and Draft Statement of Scope

The Commission approved opening a rulemaking docket, accepted a Statement of Scope for submission to the Governor's office and directed Commission staff to prepare and transmit the necessary documents to the Governor's office. If the Governor approves the Statement of Scope, Commission staff is directed to prepare and submit the necessary documents to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the *Wisconsin Administrative Register* and concurrently to the Department of Administration.

9300-PLI-104 - Investigation of the Complaint of Chad Mecus against Olameter, Referred to the Commission Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 182.0175(3)(br)2.

Review of Proposed Final Decision

The Commission reviewed the record and Proposed Final Decision of the Administrative Law Judge and accepted the Proposed Final Decision without modification, and directed the final decision be signed by the Secretary to the Commission.

5-EI-156 - Investigation of Electric Vehicle Policy and Regulation

The Commission modified and approved the final Order regarding the Commission's investigation of electric vehicle policy and regulation and directed it to be signed by the Secretary to the Commission.

Commissioner Nowak dissented.

The Commission directed that the order be signed by the Secretary to the Commission.
